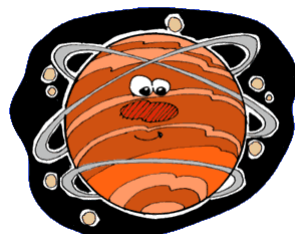
Message from Mr Waters for Year 1 pupils
