Casual Lunchtime Supervisor and Casual Cleaner

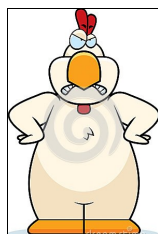

LACHES WOOD

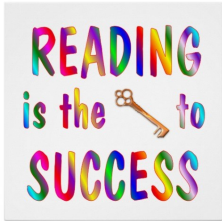
A reminder to parents of Year 3 & Year 4 whose children are going to Laches Wood in May.
